We are delighted to announce that Newbury Astronomical Society will start holding their Astronomy meetings for people with no previous knowledge of Astronomy in Stockcross Village Hall on the third Wednesday of every month at 7.00pm starting in January. Everyone of all ages are welcome to come along and you don't have to be a mem-



ber of NAS to attend. Cost is £2 per meeting paid when you arrive and hot drinks and doughnuts are included in the interval! Each month there are a several short presentations on a variety of themes to give people more knowledge about astronomy such as stars, planets and what you can see in the sky each month.



NAS is also holding an event on Wednesday 10th November in the Village Hall which will be a practical workshop session starting at 7.30pm when there will be lots of telescopes available and a presentation on the pros and cons of the different types of telescopes available. If it's clear we will also have observing so you can look through the telescopes at whatever stars

We bought our defibrillator in 2017, raising money for it via a Village Lottery and it's been sitting in the entrance to the Village Hall ever since. We had a face to face training session in August 2017 to show people how to use it but the Village Hall Management Committee thought it might be useful for people to see a refresher video of how to use it. It's actually very simple and once you switch it on a recorded voice in the machine tells you exactly what to do.

We hope you find this short video useful

There are three resources we use during our training, all three would be good to look at. Before I list them they may show mouth-to-mouth CPR which under normal circumstances we would promote. However please be aware under Covid-19 the recommendations have changed to hands-only CPR. Please see Resus UK for more information (and a video):
