Save the Rising Sun

On Tuesday 21st December 2021, we will be holding a meeting in the Sutton Hall to hear people's views on the future of the

Rising Sun.

Many of you will be aware that the Rising Sun was registered as an Asset of Community Value (ACV). Since it was put up for sale in November, an unincorporated association has been formed to try to find a way of reopening the pub and to prevent its redevelopment as housing. We have since sought and obtained a six-month moratorium to prevent its sale, effective from 23 November 2021.

Join us in the Sutton Hall, the bar will be open from 7:30pm and the meeting will start at 8pm.

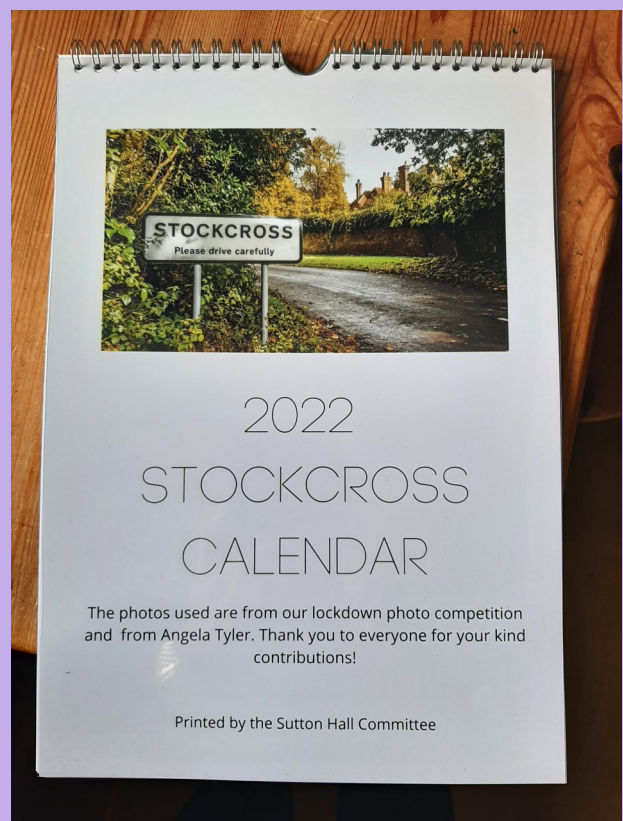
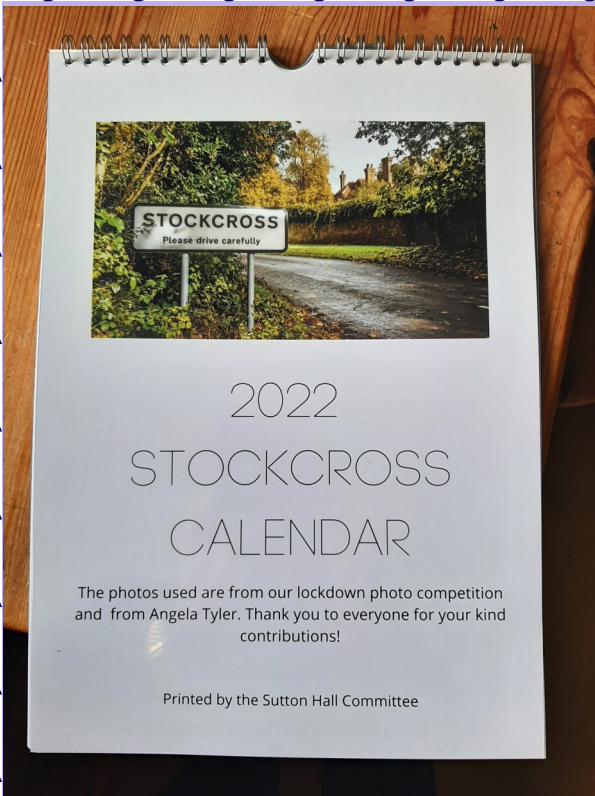


Get your limited edition Stockcross Calendar.

We bought our defibrillator in 2017, raising money for it via a Village Lottery and it's been sitting in the entrance to the Village Hall ever since. We had a face to face training session in August 2017 to show people how to use it but the Village Hall Management Committee thought it might be useful for people to see a refresher video of how to use it. It's actually very simple and once you switch it on a recorded voice in the machine tells you exactly what to do.

We hope you find this short video useful

There are three resources we use during our training, all three would be good to look at. Before I list them they may show mouth-to-mouth CPR which under normal circumstances we would promote.
